GENERAL LIABILITY WAIVER AND RELEASE

The prevailing party in the arbitration shall be entitled to an award of reasonable attorney fees and costs. The arbitration shall be governed by the laws of the State of New York.

You agree to follow all social distancing guidelines set forth by the CDC, World Health Organization ("WHO") and New York State Department of Health, to implement contact avoidance wherever and whenever possible, to wear your face mask whenever possible, and to adhere to strict clean hygiene practices, including frequent handwashing.
